CHBAMHA TEAM JERSEY AND EQUIPMENT GUIDELINES

- 1. Teams are responsible for collecting a \$100.00 cheque post-dated April 30th, 2019 from each player prior to coaches picking up jerseys.
- 2. Cheques will be returned to coaches once a full set of team home and a full set of team away jerseys are cleaned and returned in acceptable condition. Both sets **MUST** be returned at the same time to reduce confusion.
- 3. Teams are responsible for assigning 1 or 2 adults to be in charge of the jerseys. They are not to be given to individual players unless for specified team functions.
- 4. Acceptable condition is defined as "normal wear" of the jersey.

 NOTE: Tears, cuts, burns, glue adhesive, rips, etc. are not considered normal wear and the cost of a replacement jersey will be the responsibility of the assigned player. Furthermore, damaged jerseys will not be returned to the player after replacement fee has been paid.
- 5. Name bars, sponsor bars and captain "C" and assistants "A" are permitted. However, they must be professionally attached to and professionally removed from the jersey. No glue of any type is to be used on the jerseys.
- 6. Lost jerseys are the financial responsibility of the assigned team.
- 7. Jerseys are to be washed according to manufacturer's directions.
- 8. The issuing of team sets of jerseys will be approximately the first week of October and/or when all (full team) deposit cheques are submitted.

OTHER CHBAMHA EQUIPMENT INFORMATION

- 1. Team socks will be available at Pro Hockey Life. These should be purchased through the CHBA Apparel program for a reduced cost through your team. Please refer to CHBAMHA Team Apparel Program and Policy.
- 2. Goalie gear for those teams without set goalies can also be picked up with the jerseys and returned at the same time.
